



What UK Maltsters hope to purchase from the 2024 Crop



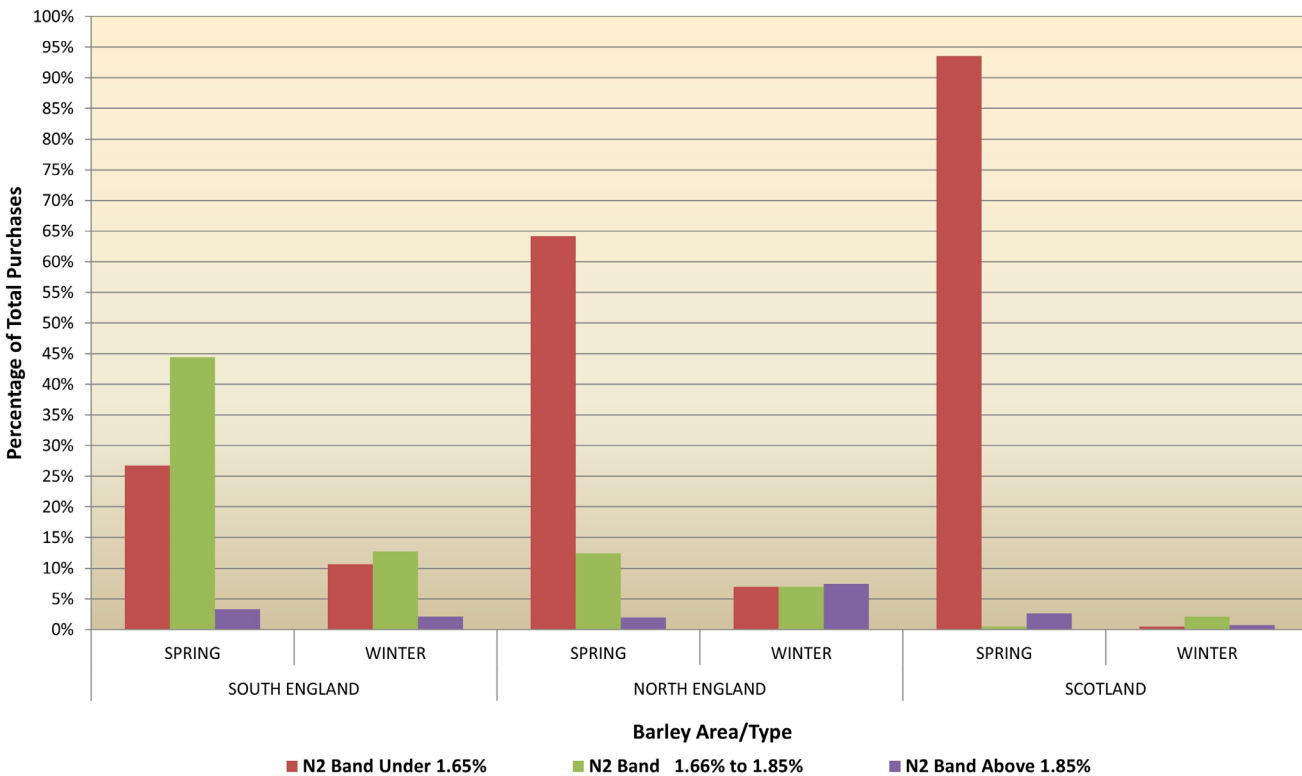
UK maltsters are likely to buy around 1.9 – 2.0 million tonnes in total of malting barley from the 2024 crop. Individual maltsters have always drawn up their detailed intended purchase lists, but such information is both confidential and commercial. However, in an effort, to help growers understand the market's needs they have agreed that the MAGB can collate information on the nitrogen bands that maltsters purchase within and show the significance of those bandings for spring and winter varieties in Scotland and England.
